- 1. Father, thank you for the privilege of being called children of God and for your Holy Spirit. As we return to you, we receive empowerment to be completely holy in everything we do just as you are holy (1 John 3:1-3, Romans 8:1-17)
- 2. Father, we receive the grace to love righteousness. We declare we will not permit anything indecent or offensive in God's eyes, but will rather bask in God's beyond-measure glorious anointing of joy as we choose purity (Titus 2:11-12, Hebrews 1:8-9, 12:14, Deuteronomy 23:14)
